DESIGNED SPECIFICALLY FOR USE ON SYNTHETIC CARPETS*

Carpet Film is a self-adhering clear polythene film perfect for short term use to protect carpets during remodeling, moving, parties, and painting. A pressure sensitive adhesive coating on one side allows it to stay firmly in place in high traffic areas.

Carpet film is water resistant and will provide temporary carpet protection that is easily installed and removed and is suitable for use up to a **maximum of 30 days**. Examine periodically and remove or replace as necessary prior to 30 days if exposed to high/low temperatures, direct sunlight or other extreme conditions.

Carpet Film is designed for use on synthetic carpets and can be easily removed without leaving any residue. Ask your dealer for products available for surfaces such as marble, tile, vinyl, glass, factory finished hard woods.

APPLICATION

1. Remove from box and retain carton for future storage
2. Locate the end of the film and pull it out several inches to determine the unwind direction
3. Apply hand pressure to the first square foot of unwound film so it adheres firmly to carpeting
4. Unroll to the desired length and reposition if necessary
5. Using a push broom on long runs will help the film adhere
6. Carefully raise the roll off the carpet and cut with scissors or blade
7. When finished, fold a small edge back against the roll for future use

STORAGE

Carpet Film should be stored in a cool area out of extreme temperatures (above 38 C or below 2 C) and away from direct sunlight. Improper storage may compromise the integrity of the adhesive.

If the product has been stored for a prolonged period (over 6 months) we recommend patch testing to ensure the integrity of the film.

Any damage occurring from improper use is the responsibility of the user and no claims for liability will be entered into where improper use has occurred.
